

## Clay County Hospital Outpatient Infusion Clinic

Services that can be provided in the Outpatient Infusion Clinic include, but are not be limited to:

- Intravenous Hydration
- Intravenous Therapy, such as Antibiotics
- Intravenous Push Medications
- Intramuscular & Subcutaneous Injections
- Administration of Blood & Blood Products
- Lab Draw From Implanted Port
- Routine Flush of Implanted Ports, Central Lines, PICC Lines
- Bladder Scan

Urinary Catheterization or Catheter Change

- Dressing Changes
- Suture or Staple Removal
- Drain Removal
- Splint Applications
- Crutch Training
- PICC Line Insertions

- Lumbar Puncture
- Paracentesis
- Thoracentesis

A written physician order with a diagnosis is required for any of these procedures.

The provider's office must make the initial appointment prior to sending a patient for outpatient therapy of any kind. This allows for proper scheduling and a decrease in the wait-time for patients receiving therapy.

Some therapies can take two hours or longer so it is important to keep your appointment.
