The Outpatient Infusion Clinic is a service that allows patients to have procedures and therapies as an outpatient, whether one-time or ongoing. The Clinic is a cost-effective alternative for the patient and can shorten inpatient hospital admission time. The Provider will make the initial appointment, and the patient will schedule additional visits as needed. The Outpatient Infusion Clinic is open seven days a week by appointment.

Services provided in the Outpatient Infusion Clinic, include but are not limited to:

- Administration of Blood and Blood Products
- Bladder Scan
- Drain Removal
- Dressing Changes
- Intramuscular & Subcutaneous Injections
- Intravenous Hydration
- Intravenous Push Medications
- Intravenous Therapy, Such as Antibiotics
- Lab Draw from Imported Port
- PICC/Port Dressing Change
- Routine Flush of Implanted Ports, Central Lines, and PICC Lines
- Suture or Staple Removal
- Therapeutic Phlebotomy
- Urinary Catheterization or Catheter Change
- Wound Care
