held for the purpose of discussing whether a particular parcel should be acquired.

- 5 ILCS 120/2 (c) (6) The setting of a price for sale or lease of property owned by the public body.

-5 ILCS 120/2(c)(11) Litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the particular public body has been filed and is pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the public body finds that an action is probable or imminent, in which case the basis for the finding shall be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting.

-5 ILCS 12/2©(12) The establishment of reserves or settlement of claims as provided in the Local Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act, if otherwise the disposition of a claim or potential claim might be prejudiced, or the review or discussion of claims, loss or risk management information, records, data, advice or communications from or with respect to any insurer of the public body or any intergovernmental risk management association or self-

<i>insurance pool of which the public body is a member.</i> -ICLS 120/2(c)(17) <i>The recruitment, credentialing, discipline or formal peer review of physicians or other health care professionals for a hospital, or other institution provided medical care, that is operated by the public body.</i> -ILCS 120/2 (c)(21) <i>Discussion of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under this Act, whether for purposes of approval by the body of the minutes or semi-annual review of the minutes as mandated by Section 2.06.</i> -5ILCS 120/2 (c)(29) <i>Collective negotiating matters between the public body and its employees or their representatives, or deliberations concerning salary schedules for one or more classes of employees.</i>
